Subsequent walks are every two weeks, so on: October 12, 26, November 9, 23, December 7, 21?.

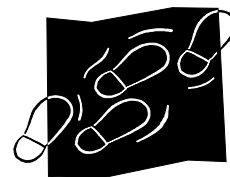
