- 12/1/03 **Elmdon & Heydon.** Circular walk of about 6 miles, on the chalk downlands around the ancient Icknield Way. Parking to be determined, probably at or near Elmdon Nature Trail (TL461395). Ring the leader first.

- 26/1/03 **Fulbourn & Wilbraham.** About 6 miles, passing Fleam Dyke (7<sup>th</sup> century earthwork). Park near the Six Bells at Fulbourn (TL 518563).
